

## Scholarship Opportunities for CoBE Students

The College of Business and Economics at the University of Hawaii at Hilo coordinates the distribution of the scholarships listed below. Students who wish to apply for one or more of these scholarships need to apply on-line at:

Applications are due by the end of February each year. Students selected to receive scholarships will be informed in May. Scholarships are awarded for use in the following academic year. Consult the following listing for minimum requirements for each scholarship.

### CoBE Tuition Scholarship

- Minimum 24 credit hours at UHH at time of application
- Minimum 3.5 GPA at UHH
- Fulltime student during award period ( $\geq 12$  credits) and maintain 3.5 GPA
- Consider academic achievement, personal statement, previous achieve
- Students involved in community or school service given priority when a tie

### Asia/Pacific Scholarship

- Minimum 24 credit hours at UHH at time of application
- Minimum 3.0 GPA at UHH
- Fulltime student during award period ( $\geq 12$  credits) and maintain 3.0 GPA
- Planned course of study must be of importance to the Pacific-Asian region
- Foreign students who are legal residents of targeted Pacific –Asia jurisdictions will be eligible to apply on the assumption that any training they receive at UHH will enhance their potential for leadership, responsibility, and service in their home country
- Students involved in community or school service given priority when a tie
- Priority to students pursuing first baccalaureate degree

### HI Island Chamber of Commerce Scholarship

- Must be an entering or continuing junior or senior during the scholarship year (Junior standing is 55 semester hours)
- Show academic excellence
- Show participation in school and community activities
- Must be of good moral character
- Fulltime student during award period ( $\geq 12$  credits)
- Prefer students who graduated from high schools on the Big Island
- Application requires 3 letters of reference from professors or instructors

### Rotary Club of Hilo Scholarship

- Must be an entering or continuing junior or senior during the scholarship year (Junior standing is 55 semester hours)

- Show academic excellence
- Show participation and service in community activities (higher priority) or university community (lower priority)
- Must be of good moral character
